The Respondent shall own the Maine coon cat.

Each party shall remove the other party from their shared accounts, including but not limited to utilities and Verizon/cell phone bill.

The Respondent shall repay the Petitioner \$800 for the vacation down payment paid by the Petitioner, and \$10,000 for materials paid by the Petitioner for the kitchen remodel.

I ask the court to make the following orders about debts:

Each partner is responsible for the debts that are now only in his/her own name.


